

**PALM HARBOR HOMES – HOME RUN INNING CONTEST  
2006 OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES – PHH/HOUSTON ASTROS**

**NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN.  
A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCE OF WINNING.  
VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.**

**1. HOW TO ENTER**

a. The Palm Harbor Home Run Inning Contest (“the Contest”) will begin on April 7, 2006, at approximately 7:05 p.m. Central Time (“CST”) and end on September 24, 2006 (the date of the final Sunday 2006 regular season Houston Astros game) at approximately 5:30 p.m. CST (“the Contest Period.”).

b. To participate in the Contest, each registrant (“Contestant”) must complete an official entry form, which includes first and last name, complete address including zip code, daytime telephone number, evening telephone number and age (must be 18 or older). Entry forms are available from participating Palm Harbor Homes Retail Sales Centers or Palm Harbor Village Retail Sales Centers (together, “Sponsor”) located in Texas at the following addresses:

c. Each Contestant must mail official entry form to “Houston Astros, Attn: Palm Harbor Promotion, 501 Crawford Street, Suite 400, Houston, TX 77001” or send a postcard with first and last name, complete address including zip code, age, daytime telephone number and evening phone number. Neither the Houston Astros nor Sponsor is responsible for lost, stolen, mangled, undelivered, postage due, illegible, incomplete or late entries. Each entry must be provided with proper postage and postmark. Entries remain valid for the entire 2006 season. Deadline for entries is 5 p.m. CST on the day prior to each drawing date. See Section 4(b).

- d. Limit one (1) entry per person, per household.

## **2. ELIGIBILITY RESTRICTIONS**

- a. The Contest is open to all Houston Astros Regular Season game attendees, KTRH Flagship Stations radio listeners and the affiliate radio listeners 18 years of age or older and who legally reside in the State of Texas. Employees of KTRH, their corporate licensee, Sponsor or the Houston Astros, their affiliated entities, advertising agencies, participating sponsors/promotional partners, other radio stations in the State of Texas and the members of their immediate families are ineligible to participate or win.
- b. Only one (1) winner per household is permitted in any Contest.
- c. Attendees and listeners are eligible to win a Houston Astros or Houston Astros Radio Network affiliate prize valued at \$600 or more only once every six (6) months.
- d. Incomplete entries will be declared invalid and shall be rejected. Contestants are required to provide truthful information and Houston Astros will reject and delete any entry it discovers to be false or fraudulent. The Houston Astros will also disqualify and delete any entry received from persons under the age of 18. The Houston Astros will also disqualify and delete any entry it discovers to be a duplicate entry. See Section 2(b).

## **3. CONTEST & PRIZE**

- a. Thirty-four (34) Houston Astros regular season home games have been designated as Sponsor Home Run Inning Contest games (“Designated Game”) on the following schedule: [April 7, April 8, April 21, April 22, May 4, May 12, May 13, May 19, May 20, June 2, June 3, June 8, June 9, June 10, June 16, June 17, June 22, July 6, July 7, July 8, July 8, July 27, July 28, July 29, August 10, August 11, August 12, August 31, September 1, September 2, September 15, September 16, September 21, September 22 and September 23.
- b. Prior to each Designated Game , a seating section in fair home run territory in the outfield will be selected at random from 17 sections (151, 152, 153, 154, 155 156, 251, 252, 253, 254, 255, 256, 257 and 258) and designated as the Official Palm Harbor Homes Home Run Section (“Designated Section”) for that game.
- c. Prior to each Designated Game, an inning within the first 5 innings will be selected at random and designated as the Official Palm Harbor Homes Home Run Inning (“Designated Inning”) for that game.
- d. Prior to each Designated Game, a Contestant will be selected at random from the entries received and designated as the Official Sponsor Home Run Inning Contestant for that game (“Official Contestant”).
- e. If any Astros player hits a home run in the Designated Inning and Designated Section, the Palm Harbor Homes Home Run Inning Official Contestant will be a “Grand Prize Winner” and receive from Sponsor a 2,356 square foot Palm Harbor Home (“Grand Prize”), 4-Bedroom, 2-Bath, 2-Living Area Model 76I3 Windsor series, valued at \$75,283. Grand Prize includes dishwasher, range, side-by-side refrigerator, fireplace and built-in entertainment center. Grand Prize does not include lot or real property, landscaping, land improvements such as grading, sidewalks, driveway, septic system or utility provisions. Grand Prize Winner is subject to the terms and conditions of the Sponsor. Additional expenses may be incurred by the Grand Prize Winner for installation requirements above and beyond a normal installation due to site restrictions, drainage or grade in elevation. All other costs associated with the Grand Prize, including, but not limited to, payment

of all federal, state and local taxes, purchase of real property lot, and recording fees, are the sole responsibility of the Grand Prize Winner. If more than one home run is hit by Astros players in the Designated Inning and Designated Section, only one (1) Grand Prize will be awarded. Any Designated Inning and Designated Section in which any Astros player hits a home run must occur during a regular season game counted as an Official League game. See Section 5(d).

- f. For the home run “winning ball” to be valid for the Contest, the ball must initially land in the Designated Section or be caught or touched by someone standing with both feet in the Designated Section. The Designated Section is defined lengthwise from any point inside the outfield railing to the back wall and laterally from the outside edge of outermost seating armrest to the opposite outermost seating armrest in the section and does not include aisles between sections. The “winning ball” must be counted as an Official League home run score.

***Scenarios for clarification purposes ...***

*If a fan in the Designated Section in the Designated Inning leans over the outfield fence and catches or touches a fly ball hit by a Astros player and is not designated as an official home run, the ball is not a valid “winning ball.”*

*If a ball is hit in the Designated Inning by a Astros player and the ball it touched by a fan that does not have both feet in the Designated Section and the ball is caught or deflected into the Designated Section, the ball is not a valid “winning ball.”*

- g. All technological equipment available to the Houston Astros will aid in the determination of a “winning ball” should it be necessary to examine questionable or close calls. Final Resolution will be at the discretion of the Houston Astros and all decisions are final.
- h. Any prize not claimed within forty-five (45) days of winning will be forfeited by the Grand Prize Winner.
- i. Contest prizes are not transferable. Prize may not be substituted for or redeemed for cash, except that Sponsor may, at its sole discretion, substitute prizes of comparable value or cash. The prizes are expressly limited to the item(s) listed above and do not include taxes, gratuities or any other expenses. Other restrictions may apply. If Grand Prize Winner is unable to accept or cannot accept the grand prize Palm Harbor Home, the Prize will be forfeited.

**4. WINNER SELECTION AND NOTIFICATION**

- a. Decisions of the Houston Astros and Sponsor management with respect to the Contest are final.
- b. One (1) Official Contestant will be chosen by random drawing from all eligible entries received for each 2006 regular season Houston Astros Designated Game played during the Contest Period. If any Astros player hits a home run in a Designated Section in the Designated Inning, the Official Contestant will be a Grand Prize Winner. Drawings of all entries received by 5 pm each Monday prior to each drawing which will be held on each Tuesday prior to the week that a Designated Game is played. One (1) Official Contestant, one (1) section and one (1) inning will be selected for each Designated Game to be played the following week. For each Designated Game, the Official Contestant, Designated Section and Designated Inning will be announced on the Houston Astros Radio Network and on the public address system at Minute Maid Park immediately prior to the Astros “at bat” rotation during the Designated Inning.
- c. Odds of winning depend upon the number of eligible entries received.

- d. If no Astros home run is made during the Designated Inning to the Designated Section, no Palm Harbor Home will be awarded.
- e. Grand Prize Winners need not listen/or be present to win. Houston Astros will attempt to notify the Grand Prize Winner by telephone immediately following the inning in which the Grand Prize Winner is determined. Official Contestants will not be notified prior to each game. If Grand Prize Winner cannot be reached by telephone, the Houston Astros will notify the Grand Prize Winner by certified mail to the address listed on the entry form.

## **5. CONDITIONS**

- a. Payments of all federal, state and local taxes are solely the responsibility of the Grand Prize Winner. Grand Prize Winners may be required to sign an IRS Form W-9 or the equivalent.
- b. By participating in the Contest, the Grand Prize Winner agrees to have his or her name, voice, or likeness used in any advertising or broadcasting material relating to this Contest without additional financial or other compensation, and, where legal, to sign a publicity release confirming such consent prior to acceptance of the prize.
- c. Prior to awarding any prize or prize certificate, the Houston Astros, the Houston Astros Radio Network and/or Sponsor in its sole discretion may require Grand Prize Winners (and their travel companions, if any) to sign a liability release, agreeing to hold Houston Astros, the Houston Astros Radio Network, their corporate licensee, Sponsor, affiliate companies and the officers, shareholders, directors, employees, agents and representatives of each of them harmless against any and all claims or liability arising directly or indirectly from the prize or participation in the Contest .
- d. The Houston Astros and/or Sponsor reserves the right to make changes in the rules of the Contest, including the substitution of a prize of equivalent value, which will become effective upon announcement. If due to circumstances beyond the control of Houston Astros, the Houston Astros Radio Network and/or Sponsor the game in which a Designated Game is cancelled for any reason prior to becoming an official game, all statistics are removed from the official score book and the Grand Prize will not be awarded. If a game is delayed or postponed before the Designated Game is played, the Contest will occur when the rescheduled or postponed game is played.
- e. Houston Astros and/or Sponsor reserve the right, but not the obligation, to cancel or modify the Contest and shall not be required to award a substitute prize.
- f. Failure to comply with the Contest rules may result in a Contestant's disqualification solely at the discretion of the Houston Astros and/or Sponsor.
- g. Houston Astros and/or Sponsor are not responsible for typographical or other errors in the printing, the offering or the administration of the Contest, or in the announcement of a prize.
